that the Principal of the College is a member of the Selection Committee and all payments are made in consultation with the Principal.

3. that all the money received by way of fees, E.B.C. Grants, the Grants received from the State or Central Government and/or the University Grants Commission are deposited in the College account in a Schedule Bank or in any of their branches. This account is operated by the Principal of the College.
4. that the management of the College makes a provision for the Provident Fund Scheme, approved by the University for the teaching as well as non-teaching staff.

6. (a) that a sum of Rs.50,000/- is spent on the purchase of equipment, apparatus etc. for laboratories of the College.
(b) that the laboratories are properly fitted furnished and made available for the use of the students, on or before 15-5-1966.
(c) that the following additional rooms are provided for the Chemistry laboratory :-
 - i) A store room of 15' x 15'
 - ii) A preparation room of 10' x 10'
 - iii) A balance room of 10' x 10'
 - iv) A room for the Gas-plant.
7. that the necessary accommodation is made available for the additional classes.
8. that a sum of Rs.25,000/- is spent on the purchase of books for the library.
9. that the authorities of the College create and maintain a Deficit Fund of Rs.40,000/- for 1966-67 and a Reserve Fund of Rs.25,000/- in a manner approved by the University.
10. that the number of students to be admitted to the relevant classes/courses is restricted as under :-

11. that the Principal gives a written undertaking that no admissions will be made to the relevant classes/courses, until all the condition of affiliation are fulfilled and specific permission from the University is received.

2. I have now to request you kindly to fulfil the conditions laid down by the University on or before 15-5-1966 and make a *report at least by 20th June, 1966. Government are being requested to grant affiliation, as recommended by the Senate, on receipt of a report from you to the effect

that the conditions laid down by the University have been fulfilled.

***N.B.:-**In view of the introduction of the revised structure of the B.A. and B.Com. Courses from June, 1966, it is necessary to comply with the conditions of affiliation, in the light of the instructions contained in Circular No. 47 of 1965-66 which has already been issued to Colleges on 16-3-1966. Your compliance Report should indicate:

- i) the actual state of the fulfilment of each of the conditions embodied in the recommendations of the Senate vis-a-vis the revision of the B.A. and B.Com. Courses from June, 1966. / If a particular condition is affected and becomes inoperative due to structural change, it may please be mentioned categorically in your report so that the matter could be adequately and properly verified at the time of an on-the spot inspection of your College by the One-Man Committee. / and also.
- ii) the actual state of the arrangements made by you in respect of the staff, library, accommodation etc. for teaching the OPTIONAL SUBJECTS, which you propose to provide for in the first year B.A. and B.Com. Classes from June, 1966.
